name on.

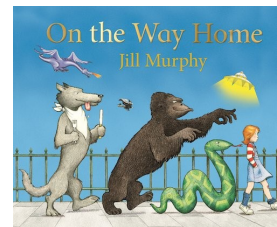
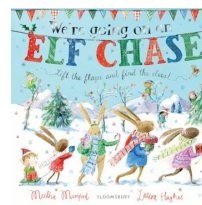
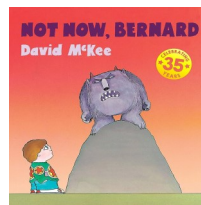
This half term we will be working
with the children to

Curriculum: We are learning...

Our topic this term is: **All about me - Looking at healthy eat, looking after our self and being independent.**

We will be using these texts:
