In History we will be studying the Anglo-Saxon invasion of Britain and how the Anglo-Saxons lived.

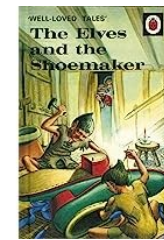
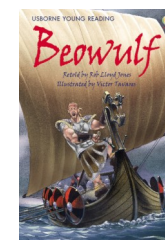
In RE we will be learning about Sikhism including celebrations, beliefs, values and religious buildings.
