Curriculum: We are learning...

Our topic this term is: **Forests**

We will be learning the rhymes: **5 Currant Buns, Three Blind Mice, Old McDonald, Old Mother Hubbard.**

We will set activities that encourage the children to recognise different animals we might find in the forest, exploring different environments and talking about things that belong to different people. We will work with the children to develop their communication skills through Speech and Language activities such as 'When I go to school' and 'This is the way'.

Our festivals/celebrations this term will be: **Easter Monday, Eid Al Fitr, Vaisakhi, World Art Day, World Health Day, Earth Day, Mental Healthy week, Walk to school week, Cultural Diversity Day, Healthy Eating week and Eid Al Adha.**
