This half term we will be working with the children to:

- Learn our class routine
- Communicate using symbols/words
- How to make a request or ask for help
- Develop our independence
- Learn new Makaton signs
- Build relationships /friendships

Our class topic is: All about me!

We will learn about personal hygiene, how to zip our coat, put on shoes and develop our own independent in daily tasks such as washing hand etc. We will learn different parts of our body e.g. head, eyes, ears and mouth and who is in my school.

We will be learning in English - how to hold a pencil to make marks with purpose, form letters of our name, explore books and learn letter sounds through speech and language games such as what's in the box/bag. In Maths we will be ordering numbers from 1-10, learning colours and shapes, counting objects and learning maths songs to 5 such as: 5 in the bed, 5 little firemen, 5 speckled frogs and 5 little snowmen.

We will set activities that encourage the children to recognise themselves and their friends, develop their communication and interaction through a range of speech and language activities and games. The children will learn through working 1:1 with an adult, in groups, taking turns or independently through exploration of the task around the classroom
