

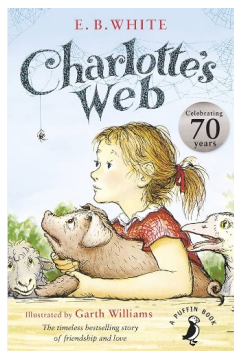


Year 9 Secondary Newsletter
