Curriculum: We are learning...

In Science we are learning about evolution.

In Creative Arts we will be studying Ndebele culture and art and looking at the artist Esther Mahlangu.

In our Social and Cultural lessons we plan to look at conflict, researching WW1 and WW2.

In Computing the children will be navigating through Microsoft PowerPoint and Excel as part of publishing and practical data handling.
