Please support children to come to school with coats as we like to make use of the outdoor areas no matter the weather. It would be very helpful if children's clothing is labelled.

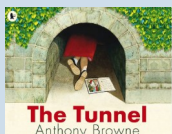
We do have a healthy eating policy and we are a nut-free site. Please make sure that any food that children bring in is healthy and nut-free.

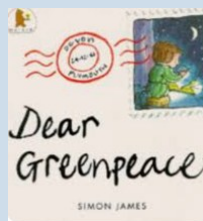
