## Maths

In Maths, we will continue to use rhymes to encourage counting and learning the sequencing of numbers . Through modelling the children will begin to use their fingers to count.

In shape, space & measure we will be working on comparing size of objects by matching, using positional language to place objects in, on & under and identifying 2D shapes



## English

Our story this half term is Rosie's Walk, the children will use the story to develop language and communication around positional language as well as engaging in listening to familiar stories.

The children will learn how to use picture cues when sharing a book, begin to anticipate key events and important phrases and derive some meaning and understanding from books.

In our writing we will focus on mark making with meaning, for example, writing our names or initial letter of name and key words from the story. To support writing we will be introducing Write dance, this will focus on the movements for writing.



## Wider curriculum

**Science**—We will focus on a range of animals and learn about their home , will group animals by their habitat and learn how they survive in their environments.

**Geography**- We will Exploring human and physical features in our environment, this will involve taking a closer look at buildings such as supermarkets, schools and factories.

**Music**—The children will work on rhythm. We will work together to compose a rhythm, first, using our body and then with the use of instruments .
