This half term we will be working with the children to:

- Sorting by colour and Size.
- Communicate using symbols/ words.
- Showing an interest in books.
- To be able to undo some buttons, zips, press studs or Velcro.
- To control scissors using finger and thumb.
- Sharing with peers.
- Have an awareness of what resources need to be put away



### Curriculum: We are learning...

Our topic this term is: Minibeasts

Where we will be leaning about different minibeasts and what the different types of minibeasts there are through exploring our texts. We will also learning about how caterpillars turn into butterflies and how spiders spin webs .

In Maths our number rhymes this term are 10 Green Bottles and 10 Fat Sausages, which we will be using to learn to count from 1-10. We will be learning how to sort by colour and size and use numicon to count and match to puzzles.

As part of our wider curriculum, we will set activities that encourage the children to work on being more independent, continue to explore different Minibeasts and explore different celebration's. We will work with the children to develop their communication skills through Speech and Language activities and build up their tolerance to different experiences and learn through a sensory approach.
